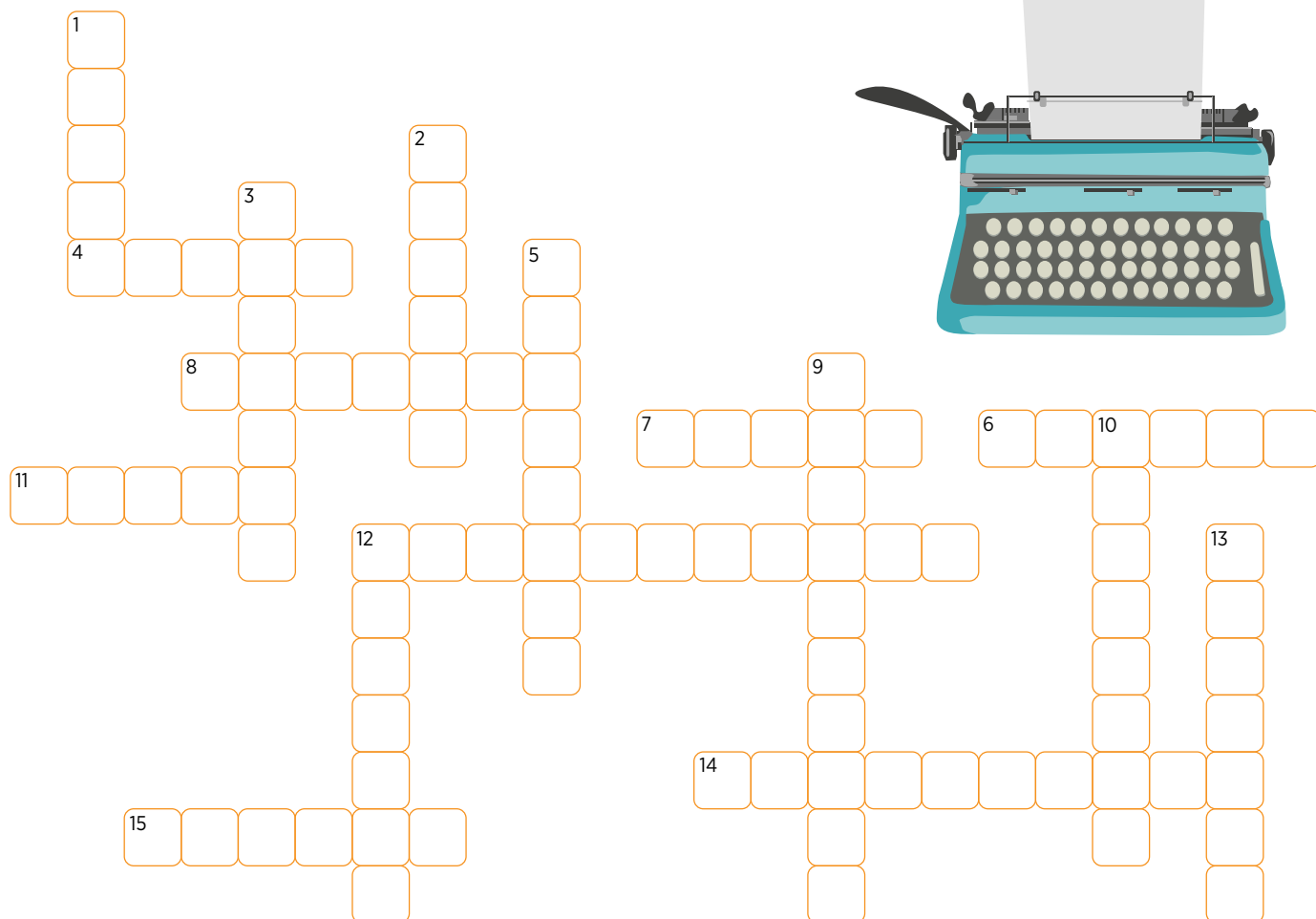


# ACTIVITY 4: BRADMAN COLLECTION CROSSWORD
