



Ticket scalping is illegal in South Australia. Tickets cannot be sold for more than 110% of the original ticket cost.

This applies to tickets:

- For a sporting or entertainment event in SA
- Sold on or after 10 December 2018
- With a re-sale restriction*.

It's safest to buy tickets from the authorised seller.

If you buy from a re-seller your ticket might not be genuine, may not be provided at all, or could be cancelled by the event organiser.

^{*}A re-sale restriction is a term or condition that limits the circumstances in which a ticket may be resold or prohibits the re-sale of the ticket
